### **Minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> International Organising Committee Meeting of the 2<sup>nd</sup> IBSSA World Martial Arts Championships and Festival 18 – 21 August 2002, Budapest, Hungary**

Prof. Giacomo S. BERTOLETTI – 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President of IBSSA was several times consulted by phone and E-mail.

The results of the very long meetings are the followings:

1. The program of the event and a detailed invitation and information was elaborated and finalised. It was agreed, that these materials must be circulated by all methods (E-mail, Internet, etc.)
2. All financial aspects were discussed and agreed.  
(Main points of the agreement between IBSSA and IBSSA Latvian Organising Committee are fixed in separate minutes.)
3. During the I. “SEC-tember” – IBSSA International Special Security Training Course, which will be held between 25-29 September 2002 in Budapest / Hungary, there will be a 2<sup>nd</sup> Organising Committee Meeting.
4. It was agreed, that between 25-27 October 2002 in Riga / Latvia a Karate Referee Course will be organised and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Organising Committee will also be held with a Press Conference.
5. It was agreed, that the event must be connected with the Latvian National Holiday – 18<sup>th</sup> November is the Independence Day of Latvia. VIP guests will have special invitation from the President of the Latvian Republics!
6. It would be very positive, if the “Federation of Autonomous Priorities of the Sovereign Order of Saint John of Jerusalem, Knights of Malta” could organise in Riga during this time a Ceremony of Investiture, because it could offer the possibility of many Knights of Malta of IBSSA to participate on that event and on the other hand the 2<sup>nd</sup> IBSSA World Martial Arts Championships and Festival could be honoured with the presence of some very high VIP personalities, some of those are holding honorary titles in IBSSA as well. (H.R.H. Prince Michael James Alexander Stewart of Albany is the Honorary President of IBSSA.)

8. During the meetings the present IBSSA officials met several active IBSSA members.
  - Dr. Oliver ROZSA (USA) – Master Teacher and gun expert was inviting the guests for a coffee and did show his excellent gun collection in Hungary.
  - Mr. Károly SIMON (HUN) – IBSSA Shooting Instructor met Dr. Rony KLUGER and the preparations of the I. “SEC-tember” were discussed.
  - Dr. Levente GYENES, KCM (HUN) – International Coordinator of IBSSA for Europe gave an official dinner to the present guests.
  
9. During the whole event there was a natural catastrophe in Europe, the Flood hit the Czech Republic, Austria, Germany, Hungary and Slovakia. The working group of IBSSA Officials were continuously reported about the heroic work of the Czech IBSSA Rescue Team, headed by Dr. Alexander CACH, KM who led the evacuations with 150 IBSSA guards in Czech Republic and Austria, and of the Hungarian team of 50 people, headed by Dr. Levente GYENES, KCM.
